


### 2.1 Japanese Automakers' Domestic and Overseas Production





### 2.2 Japanese Automakers' Production Sites\* Worldwide (as of 2015)








#### 2.3 Japanese Automakers' Global Production Volumes














### 2.5 Japanese Automakers in the EU: Trends in Local Production / Imports from Japan






- EU production by Japanese automakers has risen steadily.
- In 2015, EU production by Japanese automakers totalled 1.40 million units.


#### 2.6 Japanese Automakers' EU-Made Vehicle Exports

#### 2.8 Japanese Automakers' Approach to Parts Procurement

- Conduct an open procurement process
  - ⇒ An "open door" transaction policy is always pursued.
- Evaluate based on Quality, Cost, Delivery, Development factors
  - ⇒ Parts must be competitive from a QCDD perspective.
- Prioritize safety, the environment, compliance
  - ⇒ Performance and regulatory compliance are critical criteria.
- Maximize globalization
  - ⇒ Parts procurement across national/regional lines is increasing.
